Conducting traffic stops 4. Investigate crimes + collect evidence 5. Maintain public safety by resolving conflicts 	<p>The Public Safety Department is responsible for coordinating public safety for the town, code inspection and ordinance enforcement functions, parking violations, and animal control.</p> <p>The mission of the Public Safety Department is to safeguard the citizens and visitors of the Town of Huntington by preserving the peace and preventing crime at Town parks, beaches and facilities.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Abandoned vehicles/illegal parking *Construction/building without permits *Graffiti *Illegal housing/apartments/signage *Litter/Debris *Parking *Destruction of Town Property

Noise		*See Town Code Chapter 141 *Excessive Noise in a manner that is plainly audible at a distance of 50 feet between 11PM and 7AM can be reported.
Outdoor Lighting		See Town Code Chapter 143

Park Rangers: The Park Rangers are New York State Peace Officers who are responsible for maintaining general public order and protecting town parks, beaches, and other town related facilities. As law enforcement officers, they also provide an additional measured level of security at town sponsored events and functions.

They can be reached via the Public Safety Command Center number. The Command Center serves as dispatch, directing assets as needed.
